Meeting of the SDARC was called to order at 6:57 PM By Rodney Scott, we had 16 members and visitors present, Rodney Scott read the minutes and were approved by the club members. Correction, Bryan's name was spelled wrong in the minutes.

Treasurer Report was given, we have \$1071.95 checking, \$3327.00 in Savings which was the same as last month. Jim moved to approve the minutes and Ellen 2nd.

We talked about Moving the Saturday morning net to a different band and / or time. We talked about try installing different Antenna's, Willie talked about the Propagation and the MUF (Maximum usable Frequency) and looking on Space weather if you want to see how the bands are doing. People that have a hard time hearing through their local noise can use the WEB-SDR or the Cedar Mountain HF Remote using RCForb or bringing up the HF Radio tied to the 448.550 UHF repeater (ONLY ONE can be used as they share the same Antenna).

Next meeting will be Sept 5th at the Ponderosa Restaurant.

Repeater report: we should be able to get Bruin back on the Network real soon by putting that portion back on the Emery County Network, Bret and Bryan will try to take care of that very soon and got it approved.

Bret Also talked about the Cedar Mt APRS that is down again and we can put one of our spare Nodes out there to replace the Broken one that Barry brought over last month. We still have a APRS Node slated for Ford Ridge that Royce paid for but it needs an Antenna and we'll need help with that. The Abajo Repeater was talked about and we still haven't been there to see why the network was getting RF in it and killing the network to the Controller, we may need to get some fiber and fiber converters to get it working properly.

Bryan made it to Boarding house and changed it's network and Bret got the Repeaters Link, VHF and 220 Repeaters reprogrammed and back on the air once Bryan got it on back on the Network.

Jim made motion to adjourn at 7:37 PM, Willie 2nd it.
